O R D E R

1. Delay in filing the special leave petition is condoned.
2. The Company Law Board as well as the High Court have concurrently found that the transfer of shares was against the Articles of Association. Based on the said finding, *inter alia*,

directions were issued to the transferor to refund the amount to the transferee.

3. As there is no dispute that transfer of shares was in violation of the Articles of Association, we do not find a good reason to interfere with the impugned order. The Special Leave Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
