Mr. Neeraj Garg, learned counsel for the petitioner. 2. Mr. Khushboo Tiwari Sharma, learned Central Government Standing Counsel for the Union of India. 3. Mr. Yogesh Pacholia, learned counsel for respondent no. 2. 4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that appeal filed by petitioner no. 2, challenging order dated 09.09.2025 passed by respondent no. 3, was allowed by National Medical Commission on 13.11.2025. However, Medical Assessment and Rating Board has not taken any decision in terms of direction issued by Appellate Authority. 5. The reliefs, sought in the writ petition, are as follows:- (i) Issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction in nature of Mandamus commanding Respondent No.3 to forthwith pass appropriate consequential order enhancing the seats for P.G. course DM-Medical Gastroenterology in petitioner no.2 college pursuant to Order dated 13.11.2025 passed by Respondent No.2 (Annexure 4 to the writ petition), (whereby the appeal of petitioners preferred against letter of



			disapproval of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, National Medical Commission, for increase of seats in P.G. course DM-Medical Gastroenterology, has been allowed), as expeditiously as possible in a time bound manner, which this Hon'ble Court deem fit and proper in facts and circumstances of the case. (ii) Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus commanding respondent no.2 to update enhanced number of seats in the seat matrix on NMC Portal with respect to petitioner no.2 institute, completing all necessary process at the earliest possible enabling petitioner no.2 to timely secure admissions over enhanced seats before commencement of next Counselling session. 6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to Medical Assessment & Rating Board to take decision in the matter in terms of directions issued by Appellate Authority (National Medical Commission), as per law, within three weeks from the date of presentation of certified copy of this order.
