UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. There is an order of eviction against the respondent passed on 10.12.2007, against which the appeal preferred by the respondent is pending before the Additional District Judge, Fast Track, First Court at Howrah since 2008.
3. When the petitioner approached the High Court

seeking a direction for early disposal of the pending appeal before the learned Additional District Judge, Fast Track, First Court, Howrah, the High Court disposed of the revision application, directing the Appellate Court to decide the miscellaneous appeal within six months, which is already over.

4. In view of the above, we dispose of this Special Leave Petition, directing the Additional District Judge, Fast Track, First Court at Howrah to decide the pending Miscellaneous Appeal No. 10 of 2008 within three months, from today.

5. The concerned court shall also submit a compliance report to this Court.
