			<u>WPMS/1563/2023</u> Padam Singh --Petitioner Versus Assistant Labour Commissioner & Others --Respondents <u>Hon'ble Manoj Kumar Tiwari, J.</u> Mr. Akshay Pradhan, Advocate, for the petitioner. Mr. N.K. Papnai, Standing Counsel, for the State. (2) According to petitioner, his wife was registered with Uttarakhand Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board and she passed away on 14.10.2020. Petitioner applied for death assistance, as per the policy applicable to registered construction workers. Since his application has not been considered so far, therefore, he has filed this writ petition seeking the following relief: <i>"i. To issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of Mandamus, directing the Respondent No. 1 to conduct an enquiry on the death assistance application dated 21.12.2020 of the Petitioner (Annexure No. 1) and grant the death assistance to the Petitioner, in a time bound manner."</i> (3) Since petitioner's application for death assistance is allegedly pending consideration before the competent authority since 21.12.2020, therefore, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to hold an enquiry on the issue of eligibility of petitioner for



		such compensation. If competent authority feels that some information/documents are necessary for taking decision in the matter, then he can call upon the petitioner to furnish such information/document. If upon enquiry, competent authority finds that petitioner is entitled to death assistance, as per the policy, then necessary order in that regard shall be passed within three months from the date of presentation of certified copy of this order.
