			<u>WPMB/726/2026</u> M/s JP Stone Crushers Private Limited --Petitioner Versus State of Uttarakhand & Others --Respondents <u>Hon'ble Manoj Kumar Tiwari, J.</u> <u>Hon'ble Siddhartha Sah, J.</u> Mr. Abhishek Darmara, Advocate for the petitioner, through VC. Mr. Rajeev Singh Bisht, Deputy AG, with Mr. B.S. Parihar, Brief Holder, for the State. (2) This writ petition is filed by one of the Directors of a private limited company, who is aggrieved by change of phone number in the web portal of Mining Department, which was submitted by other two Directors of the company. Petitioner contends that such change could not have been effected without his consent. (3) Mr. Piyush Garg, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of other two Directors, namely, Mr. Saket Agarwal and Mr. Tarun Bansal, who are not impleaded as party respondent. He submits that Board of Directors passed a resolution for change of phone number, submitted to the Mining Department, and the said resolution was supplied to the Mining Department and based on that resolution, phone number was changed in the web portal of the department. He submits that internal dispute between two or more individual



			Directors cannot be resolved in a writ petition. (4) Mr. Rajeev Singh Bisht, learned State Counsel, on instructions, submits that out of three Directors of the petitioner company, two had requested for change of phone number, which was uploaded in the web portal of the Mining Department and based on such request, necessary change was made. He also submits that if there is any internal dispute within the company, between two or more Directors, such dispute can only be resolved before National Company Law Tribunal. (5) We find substance in the submissions made by learned State Counsel and learned Counsel for other two Directors. Thus there is no scope for interference in the matter.
