1. In the present writ petition, following prayer has been made:-

“For issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the notification dated 31.12.2013 (Annexure P-1) under Section 4 and declaration dated 10.08.2018 (Annexure P-2) under Section 6 of the old Land Acquisition Act, 1894, read with Section 24 (1) (a) of Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Re-settlement Act, 2013 as declaration is beyond the prescribed limit of 1 year under the Old Act, 1894 of issuance of notification under Section 4 dated 31.12.2013 and also the notification under Section 4 has lapsed after the enactment of Right to Fair Compensation and

Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Re-settlement Act, 2013 and the declaration under Section 6 is hit by Section 24 of the new Act.

2. Prayer in the application bearing No.CM-11130-CWP-2026 is for withdrawal of the present writ petition. The said application is supported by an affidavit.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he has already filed separate writ petition i.e. CWP No.26549 of 2023 and thus, he seeks to withdraw the main writ petition.

4. In view of the above, the application bearing No.CM-11130-CWP-2026 is allowed and petitioner is permitted to withdraw the main writ petition.
