Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the subject matter of the case relate to alleged recovery of 62.7 kgs of ganja from a rented house which do not belong to the present petitioner. Charge-sheet has already been submitted and the charge-sheet was submitted at the extended period of time which was granted by the learned trial Court without any cogent reason. Petitioner is in custody for more than 7 months.

Learned advocate appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail and draws the attention of the Court to the seizure list.

I have taken into account the materials appearing in the Case Diary and the quantum of seizure in the present case, I am of the opinion that rigors of Section 37 of the NDPS Act is attracted.

As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner in CRM (NDPS) 1396 of 2026 is **rejected**.
