Pursuant to Regulation 30 read with Schedule III of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“SEBI Listing Regulations”), and in furtherance of the disclosure made by the Company to the Stock Exchanges on 4th July 2024, we hereby inform you that the Company has received a Show Cause Notice (“SCN”) on 25th May 2026 from the Directorate General of GST Intelligence (“the GST Authority”), issued under Section 74(1) of the Central Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017, whereby a demand of Rs. 20,51,00,281/- (Rupees Twenty Crore Fifty-One Lakh Two Hundred Eighty-One only) has been raised by the GST Authority.

The Company is evaluating the SCN and, based on advice from its tax advisors, shall file a detailed reply with the adjudicating authority within the prescribed timelines, and shall pursue all legal remedies available to it.
