O R D E R

1. The appeal is directed against the second appellate judgment and decree dated 13th August, 2015 passed by a learned Judge of the High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh¹, dismissing the appeal² under Section 100 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 of the appellant-Haryana State Agricultural Marketing Board³.

2. It appears on a reading of the impugned judgment that the suit instituted by the respondent was decreed, whereupon a first appeal carried by the appellant-Board from such decree was also dismissed.

3. In dismissing the second appeal, the learned Judge of the High Court relied on an earlier decision dated 21st May, 2009 of the High Court in R.S.A-1622-2008 as well as decision dated 3rd April, 2006 in R.S.A-829-2006.

4. It is not in dispute that the special leave petition⁴, which was carried from the order dated 21st May, 2009 in R.S.A-1622-2008, stands dismissed by an order dated 22nd March, 2010 of this Court.

5. Learned counsel appearing for the appellant-Board fairly submitted that the order passed by the High Court dated 21st May, 2009 in R.S.A-1622-2008 has duly been implemented.

6. In such view of the matter, there is no reason to entertain this appeal under Article 136 of the Constitution of India. It must meet the same fate as Special Leave Petition (Civil) No.9584 of 2010.

7. The civil appeal is, accordingly, dismissed.
