1 What was the most difficult moment in Mach's journey when you genuinely wondered, 'How are we going to get through this'?

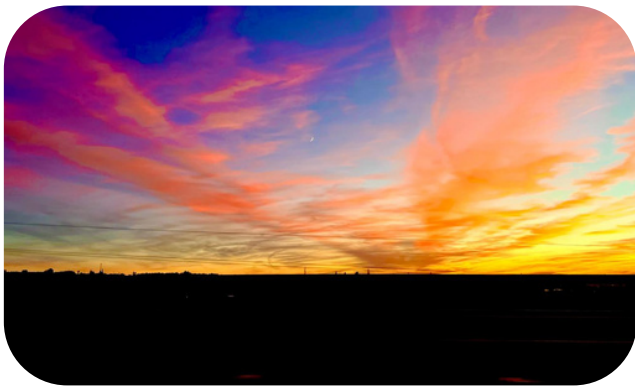

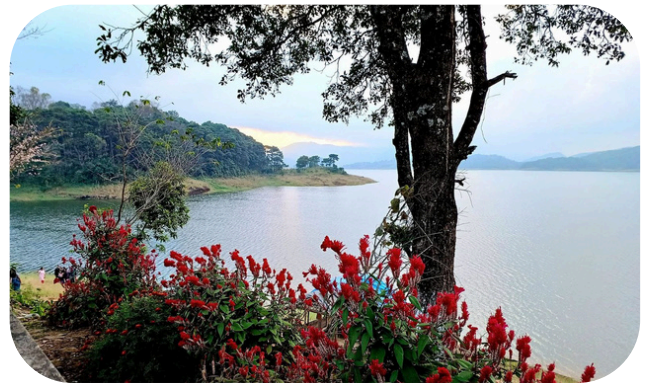

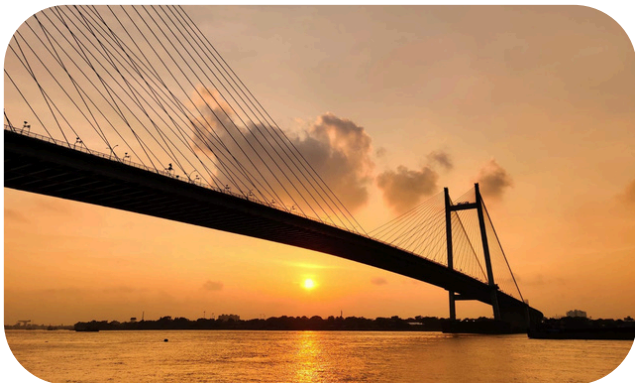
