UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. This Court has passed an order dated 12.05.2026 in Civil Appeal No.8363 of 2026 (@ SLP (Civil) No.4717 of 2026), "*The New India Assurance Company Ltd. Versus Liya and Others*" and the amount of compensation which was

awarded by the High Court is Rs.1,27,52,500/- was reduced to Rs.73,49,500/- by this Court. This Court in paragraph 9 of the order dated 12.05.2026 passed by this Court has categorically observed that the compensation shall carry rate of interest at the rate of 8% per annum, as ordered by the High Court. In considered opinion of this Court, the aforesaid sentence is in reference to the rate of interest and nothing more.

2. The matter was referred to Registrar of this Court to resolve the dispute and the Registrar in respect of apportionment has held that the 1st Claimant/Respondent No.1 shall be entitled to 75%, 2nd Claimant/Respondent No.2 shall be entitled to 12.5% and 3rd Claimant/Respondent No.3 shall be entitled to 12.5% of the total amount.

3. In the present case, after the award was passed, the claimants received a sum of Rs.38,55,344/- along with interest @ 8% per annum, and the amount arrived at by this Court was Rs.73,49,500/-. The interest rate applicable, as per the order of this Court, is 8% per annum, which is the interest rate awarded by the High Court. In the present case, the interest payable from 14.01.2015, i.e., the date of filing of the petition before the MACT, till the date of actual realization, which is taken to be 23.09.2025 for the purpose of calculation, comes to Rs.32,68,109/-, and therefore, the total amount now payable comes to Rs.67,62,265/-.

4. This Court is in the considered opinion that the claimants are entitled for a sum of Rs.67,62,265/-. The remaining amount be credited to the New India Assurance Company Ltd.-Insurance Company positively within one week from today.

5. In view of aforesaid, the Miscellaneous Application stands disposed of.
