UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Heard Mr. Neeraj Kishan Kaul, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners, Mr. Siddharth Bhatnagar, learned senior counsel appearing on caveat for respondent No.1 and Mr. Lakshmeesh S.Kamath, learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2.
2. Considering the fact that the impugned order is an interim order, we are not inclined to interfere with the same.
3. At this stage, learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that the amount of Rs.11,00,00,000/- (Rupees eleven crores) has been arrived at by the Municipal Corporation without any basis.
4. If the petitioners have any grievance regarding the quantum, they may move the High Court with an appropriate application for modification of the order.
5. We grant time to the petitioners to move an application for modification with regard to the quantum, if so advised, before the High Court on or before 18th September, 2026. Needless to state that the High Court will decide the same uninfluenced by the observations in this order.

6. Till then, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioners.

7. With the aforesaid observations, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.

8. Pending application shall stand disposed of.
