UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Pursuant to the earlier orders of this Court the alleged contemnors i.e. Prakash J. Barot, Umesh Parshuram Rao, Mohan Yashwat Naik and Ashok Vithal Suwant, are present in Court.
2. it is not disputed by Mr. Ragenth Basant, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners that payment of the instalment amount of Rs.1 crore has been made by the due date i.e. 26th August, 2026.
3. However, he submits that the next instalment of Rs. 1 crore falls due on 26th October, 2026 and that payment may be directed to be effected.

4. In such view of the matter, we grant liberty to the alleged contemnors to make payment of the next instalment by the due date.
5. Re-list the contempt petition on 2nd November, 2026. Personal presence of the alleged contemnor(s) is dispensed with, for the time being.
