Prayer in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari*, for quashing the impugned orders dated 18.02.2025 (Annexure P-16) and 30.11.2023 (Annexure P-15) issued by respondent/Department. Further prayer has been made to restrain the respondents from recovering the principal amount and interest and during the pendency of the instant writ petition, the operation of impugned orders of recovery dated 18.02.2025 (Annexure P-16) and 30.11.2023 (Annexure P-15) be stayed.

Learned State counsel, on the last date of hearing, was directed to get instructions as to whether the petitioners are similarly placed as the petitioners in CWP-27193-2025, which was disposed of



on the basis of the statement made on behalf of respondent/Department vide order dated 17.10.2025 (Annexure P-21).

In response thereto, learned State counsel has filed written instructions on behalf of the respondent/Department today in the Court, which is taken on record as 'Mark X'.

Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the present petition may be disposed of in terms of the order dated 21.03.2023 passed in similar writ petition i.e. **CWP-26715-2018**, titled as ***Alok Kumar and others vs State of Haryana and others***.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of and the respondent/Department is restrained from effecting any recovery from the petitioners till the decision of the case i.e. **CWP-12052-2019**, titled as ***Samunder Singh and others vs State of Haryana and others***.
