NOTES:

1. Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA") vide its General Circular No. 03/2025 dated September 22, 2025 read with circulars issued earlier on the subject ("MCA Circulars") and the applicable provisions of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("SEBI Listing Regulations"), have permitted companies to conduct the Annual General Meeting ("AGM"/"the meeting") through Video Conference ("VC") / Other Audio-Visual Means ("OAVM") subject to compliance of various conditions mentioned therein. In compliance with the aforesaid MCA Circulars, the applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the rules framed thereunder, the 45th AGM of the Company is being convened and conducted through VC. The deemed venue for the AGM shall be the Registered Office of the Company.
2. Generally, a member entitled to attend and vote at the meeting is entitled to appoint a proxy to attend and vote on a poll instead of himself and the proxy need not be a member of the Company. Since this AGM is being held through VC / OAVM pursuant to the MCA Circulars, physical attendance of members has been dispensed with. Accordingly, the facility for appointment of proxies by the members will not be available for the AGM and hence the Proxy Form and Attendance Slip are not annexed hereto. However, in pursuance of Section 112 and Section 113 of the Companies Act, 2013, representatives of the members such as the President of India or the Governor of a State or body corporate can attend the AGM through VC/OAVM and cast their votes through e-voting.
3. An Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, setting out the material facts and reasons for the resolutions in respect of the business set out above is annexed hereto.
4. The relevant details as required under Regulation 36(3) of SEBI Listing Regulations and Secretarial Standard on General Meetings ("SS-2"), issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India, in respect of Directors seeking appointment/re-appointment at this AGM is also annexed as **Annexure-A**.
5. Since the AGM will be held through VC/ OAVM, the route map of the venue of the Meeting is not annexed hereto.
6. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended) and Regulation 44 of SEBI Listing Regulations (as amended), Secretarial Standards on General Meetings ("SS-2") issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India and MCA Circulars the Company is providing facility of remote e-voting to its Members in respect of the business to be transacted at the AGM. For this purpose, the Company has entered into an agreement with Central Depository Services (India) Limited ("CDSL") for facilitating voting through electronic means, as the authorized e-Voting's agency. The facility of casting votes by a member using remote e-voting as well as the e-voting system during the AGM will be provided by CDSL.
7. The Members can join the AGM in the VC/OAVM mode 30 minutes before and after the scheduled time of commencement of the Meeting by following the procedure mentioned in the Notice. The facility of participation at the AGM through VC/OAVM will be made available to atleast 1000 members on first come first served basis. This will not include large Shareholders (Shareholders holding 2% or more shareholding), Promoters, Institutional Investors, Directors, Key Managerial Personnel, the Chairpersons of the Audit Committee, Nomination and Remuneration Committee and Stakeholders Relationship Committee, Auditors etc. who are allowed to attend the AGM without restriction on account of first come first served basis.
8. The attendance of the Members attending the AGM through VC/OAVM will be counted for the purpose of ascertaining the quorum under Section 103 of the Companies Act, 2013.
9. In case of joint holders attending the meeting, only such joint holder who is higher in the order of names will be entitled to vote at the Meeting.
10. The Voting rights of Members shall be in proportion to their shares of the paid-up Equity Share Capital of the Company as on Cut-off Date of **September 11, 2026**.
11. Institutional/Corporate members (i.e. other than individuals/HUF, NRI etc) are required to send a scanned copy (PDF/JPEG format) of its Board or Governing Body resolution/authorisation etc authorising its representative to attend the AGM through VC/OAVM on its behalf and to vote through remote e-voting pursuant to section 113 of the Act. The said resolution/ authorisation shall be sent to the Company via email through its registered email address at cs@hphthreads.com with a copy to siroyam@gmail.com.

DISPATCH OF ANNUAL REPORT THROUGH ELECTRONIC MODE

12. In compliance with the MCA Circulars and Regulation 36 of SEBI Listing Regulations, the Notice of the AGM along with the Annual Report 2025-26 is being sent only through electronic mode to those Members whose email addresses are registered with the Company/ Depositories. Member(s) may also note that the Notice of the Meeting and the Annual Report for FY 2025-26 will also be available on the Company's website at <http://www.hpthreads.com/annual-reports.php>, websites of the Stock Exchange i.e. BSE Limited at www.bseindia.com. The AGM Notice is also disseminated on the website of CDSL (agency for providing the Remote e-voting facility and e-voting system during the AGM) i.e. www.evotingindia.com.

Additionally, as per Regulation 36(1)(b) of the SEBI Listing Regulations, a letter providing the weblink, including the exact path, where complete details of the Annual Report are available, will be sent to those shareholder(s) who have not registered their email address with the Company/Depositories.

However, the Shareholders of the Company may request physical copy of the Annual Report from the Company by sending a request at cs@hpthreads.com, in case they wish to obtain the same.

13. For receiving all communication (including Annual Report) from the Company electronically:
- Members holding shares in dematerialised form are requested to register / update their e-mail address with the relevant Depository Participant.
 - Members holding shares in physical form are requested to follow the process set out in Note No. 38 in this Notice.

14. INTRUCTIONS FOR SHAREHOLDRES FOR REMOTE E-VOTING ARE AS UNDER:

- The voting period begins on **September 15, 2026 at 9:00 A.M. and ends on September 17, 2026 at 5:00 P.M.** During this period shareholders of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date (record date) of **September 11, 2026** may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.

- Shareholders who have already voted prior to the meeting date would not be entitled to vote at the meeting venue.
- Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level.

Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

(iv) Access through depositories CDSL/NSDL E-Voting system in case of Individual Shareholders holding shares in demat mode

In terms of SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/ CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by the Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.

(v) **Access through CDSL E-Voting system in case of shareholders holding shares in physical mode and non-individual shareholders in demat mode**

2. Click on "Shareholders" module.
3. Now enter your User ID
 - a. For CDSL: 16 digits beneficiary ID,
 - b. For NSDL: 8 Character DP ID followed by 8 Digits Client ID,
 - c. Shareholders holding shares in Physical Form should enter Folio Number registered with the Company.
4. Next enter the Image Verification as displayed and Click on Login.

- (x) On the voting page, you will see "RESOLUTION DESCRIPTION" and against the same the option "YES/NO" for voting. Select the option YES or NO as desired. The option YES implies that you assent to the Resolution and option NO implies that you dissent to the Resolution.
- (xi) Click on the "RESOLUTIONS FILE LINK" if you wish to view the entire Resolution details.
- (xii) After selecting the resolution you have decided to vote on, click on "SUBMIT". A confirmation box will be displayed. If you wish to confirm your vote, click on "OK", else to change your vote, click on "CANCEL" and accordingly modify your vote.
- (xiii) Once you "CONFIRM" your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.
- (xiv) You can also take a print of the votes cast by clicking on "Click here to print" option on the Voting page.
- (xv) If a demat account holder has forgotten the login password then Enter the User ID and the image verification code and click on Forgot Password & enter the details as prompted by the system.

(xvi) There is also an optional provision to upload BR/ POA if any uploaded, which will be made available to scrutinizer for verification.

(xvii) **Additional facility for Non – Individual Shareholders and Custodians – For Remote Voting only**

In terms of Section 149, 152 read with Schedule IV to the Companies Act, 2013 ("Act"), an Independent Director shall hold office for a term of up to five consecutive years on the Board of a Company but shall be eligible for re-appointment on passing of a Special Resolution by the Company and disclosure of such appointment in the Board's Report. In compliance thereof, the approval of the Members for re-appointment of the said Independent Director through Special Resolution is being sought prior to expiry of his first term.

Based on recommendation of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee ("NRC Committee") of the Board of Directors, on the basis of Performance Evaluation Report, the Board through resolution passed in its meeting held on August 07, 2026 has recommended the re-appointment of Mr. Vikram Sumatilal Sheth as an Independent Director, not liable to retire by rotation and to hold office for a second term of five (5) consecutive years, with effect from April 30, 2027 till April 29, 2032, in accordance with Nomination and Remuneration Policy and Articles of Association of the Company, on such terms and conditions as decided by the Board of Directors of the Company subject to approval of the members.

The performance evaluation of Mr. Vikram Sumatilal Sheth was carried out by the NRC Committee based on various criteria, inter-alia, including Knowledge and Competency, Fulfilment of Functions, Ability to function as a team, Initiative, Availability and attendance, Commitment, Contribution, Integrity, etc. Given the high-performance ratings received by Mr. Vikram Sumatilal Sheth in his performance evaluation and his professional background and experience and contributions made by him during his tenure, the Board, basis the recommendation of NRC Committee, is of the view that continued association of Mr. Vikram Sumatilal Sheth as an Independent Director of the Company would be of immense benefit and value to the Company. Accordingly, the Board recommends the re-appointment of Mr. Vikram Sumatilal Sheth as an Independent Director as proposed in the Resolution set out at Item No. 4 of the accompanying Notice for approval by the Members.

The Company has received a notice in writing from a member under Section 160 of the Act proposing the candidature of Mr. Vikram Sumatilal Sheth for the office of Director of the Company. Mr. Vikram Sumatilal Sheth is not disqualified from being appointed as a Director in terms of Section 164 of the Act and has given his consent to act as a Director. He has also confirmed that he is not debarred from holding the office of Director by virtue of any order by SEBI or any other authority. The Company has received a declaration from Mr. Vikram Sumatilal Sheth that he meets the criteria of independence as prescribed both under sub-section (6) of Section 149 of the Act and & Regulation 16(1)(b) under the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("SEBI Listing Regulations"). He has also confirmed that he is in compliance with Rules 6(1) and 6(2) of the Companies (Appointment and Qualification of Directors) Rules, 2014, with respect to the registration with the data bank of Independent Directors maintained by the Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs.

In the opinion of the Board, Mr. Vikram Sumatilal Sheth is a person of integrity, possesses relevant expertise / experience and fulfils the conditions for his re-appointment as an Independent Director as specified in the Act and the SEBI Listing Regulations. Mr. Vikram Sumatilal Sheth is independent of the management and possesses appropriate skills, experience and knowledge.

It is proposed to authorize the Board of Directors (the "Board" which term shall be deemed to include the Nomination and Remuneration Committee of the Board), to alter and vary the

terms and conditions of his appointment and /or remuneration or any part thereof, from time to time in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, rules framed thereunder and SEBI Listing Regulations.

Save and except Mr. Vikram Sumatilal Sheth, and his relatives to the extent of their respective shareholding interest, if any, in the Company for Item no. 4, none of the other Directors / Key Managerial Personnel and their relatives are in any way, concerned or interested, financially or otherwise, in the resolution set out in Item no. 4.

Item No. 5

Mr. Raghavkumar Agarwal (DIN: 02836610) was re-appointed as Whole-Time Director, designated as Executive Director ("ED"), Chief Executive Officer ("CEO") and Chief Financial Officer ("CFO") of the Company by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on August 12, 2023, and the said re-appointment, along with the remuneration payable to him, was subsequently approved by the Members of the Company at their Annual General Meeting held on September 28, 2023, for a period of five (5) years with effect from May 30, 2024.

In accordance with the provisions of Sections 196, 197, 198 and 203 read with Schedule V of the Companies Act, 2013 ("Act"), in case of inadequate or no profits, the Company is permitted to pay remuneration to its managerial personnel within the limits specified under Schedule V of the Act, and in accordance with Nomination and Remuneration Policy and Article of Association of the Company and based on the recommendations of Nomination & Remuneration Committee ("NRC Committee") and Audit Committee dated August 07, 2026 and subject to approval of the Members by way of a Special Resolution for a period not exceeding three (3) years.

Accordingly, the approval of the Members for payment of remuneration under Schedule V of the Act to Mr. Raghavkumar Agarwal is valid only up to May 29, 2027. Therefore, it is necessary to seek fresh approval of the Members by way of a Special Resolution for payment of remuneration to Mr. Raghavkumar Agarwal for the remaining period of his tenure, i.e., from December 01, 2026 to May 29, 2029, notwithstanding that the Company may have no profits or its profits may be inadequate during the said period.

For the purpose of calculating the above ceiling, allowances and perquisites shall be evaluated as per income tax rules, wherever applicable. In the absence of any such rules, perquisites and allowances shall be evaluated at actual cost.
- iv. **Retiral/Other Benefits:** He shall also be entitled to Company's Contribution to Provident and Superannuation Funds, Gratuity and Encashment of Leave as per the rules of the Company.
- v. **Reimbursement of Expenses:** Expenses incurred for travelling, boarding and lodging including for Mr. Raghavkumar Agarwal's spouse and attendant(s) during business trips or any other expense for the purpose of the business of the Company shall be reimbursed at actuals and not considered as perquisites.
- vi. **Performance Pay/Commission:** He shall also be entitled to a performance pay, based on his performance, and/or Commission as determined by the Board / Nomination and Remuneration Committee of the Company, from time to time,

which may exceed overall ceilings on managerial remuneration specified in Section 197 read with Schedule V of the Companies Act, 2013.

B. Others

- i. Mr. Raghavkumar Agarwal will perform his duties as such with regard to all work of the Company and will manage and attend to such business and carry out the orders and directions given by the Board from time to time in all respects.
- ii. He shall act in accordance with the Articles of Association of the Company and shall abide by the provisions contained in Section 166 of the Act with regard to duties of directors.
- iii. He shall adhere to the Company's Code of Conduct & Ethics.
- iv. The appointment may be terminated by either party by giving the other party three months' notice in writing of such termination or by paying Basic Salary in lieu of the notice period.

In the opinion of the Board, Mr. Raghavkumar Agarwal has demonstrated exemplary leadership and made significant contributions in driving operational excellence, strengthening internal capabilities, and establishing a clear strategic direction for the Company's growth and realignment.

Brief resume and other details of Mr. Raghavkumar Agrawal are provided in the **Annexure - A** to the Notice, pursuant to the provisions of (i) SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("SEBI Listing Regulations") and (ii) Secretarial Standard on General Meetings ("SS-2"), issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India.
