UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Heard Mr. L Narsimha Reddy, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner(s)/appellant(s) and Mr. Dama Seshadri Naidu, learned Senior Counsel appearing on caveat for the respondent(s).
2. Leave granted.
3. Pending hearing of these appeals before this Court, the following operative order dated 02.11.2022 (paragraph 21), passed by the Telangana State Waqf Tribunal at Hyderabad shall operate:-

"21. RESULT

As a result, in the above said circumstances, this Tribunal keeping in view the necessity to enable the continuance of daily rituals and prayers unaffected, in the Khankah-e-Nooria (Wakf Alal Aulaad) and Rouza-e Nooria. i.e., known as Dargah Noori Shah this Tribunal hereby inclined to allow the petitioner No.3 and respondent to continue with their individual daily prayers and performing rituals separately without interfering with each other, in doing so, while keeping the peace, tranquility and decorum of the subject institution, undisturbed till the disposal of the main suit."

4. Parties have favourably responded to the suggestion of the Court that an attempt should be made for an amicable resolution to the dispute through the process of mediation.
5. We refer the matter to the Mediation Centre attached to the High Court for The State of Telangana at Hyderabad.

6. The Coordinator of the said Mediation Centre may assign a senior Mediator, who is well-versed in the tenets of the law.

7. Liberty is granted to mention in the event of any settlement being arrived at.
