1. Heard Mr. A. Acharya, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. T. Sahu, learned counsel for the Opposite Parties (Bank).

2. It is submitted on behalf of the Petitioner that her representation for settlement of the loan account on OTS is pending with the Bank. It is further submitted that after death of the original loanee, the present Petitioner, who is his wife, has prayed for clearing of the loan amount through OTS and the property concerned is her residential house.

3. Mr. Sahu, learned counsel for the Opposite Parties (Bank) submits that the total outstanding amount as on date is Rs.11,50,000/-.

4. Upon hearing both parties and considering the limited prayer of the Petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Branch Manager, Union Bank of India, Puti Gopalpur



Chatrapur Branch, Upper Bus Stand, Chatrapur, Ganjam (Opposite Party No.2) to consider the grievance of the Petitioner as per her representation at Annexure-4 and dispose of the same, in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with a copy of the writ petition. Till such decision is taken by Opposite Party No.2, no coercive action shall be taken against the Petitioner.

5. An urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application.
