1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. In the present CMP, the Petitioner seeks a direction from this Court to the learned Senior Civil Judge, Bhubaneswar, for analogous hearing of Civil Suit No.1760 of 2024, Civil Suit No.1858 of 2024 and Civil Suit No.1801 of 2024, as all the aforesaid suits arise out of the same scheduled land and are pending before the learned Senior Civil Judge, Bhubaneswar.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner, Opposite Party Nos. 1 and 2 have respectively filed Civil Suit No.1760 of 2024, Civil Suit No.1858 of 2024 and Civil Suit No.1801



of 2024 before the learned Senior Civil Judge, Bhubaneswar, and the said suits are pending for adjudication.

5. Learned counsel for the Petitioner further submits that, although the aforesaid suits have been filed by different persons, the dispute involved therein pertains to the same property. Hence, the said suits may be heard analogously by the learned Senior Civil Judge, Bhubaneswar. He further contends that separate hearing of the suits is likely to consume considerable time and may result in conflicting findings. Therefore, in order to avoid unnecessary delay and the possibility of different findings, analogous hearing of the said suits would facilitate their expeditious and effective adjudication.
6. In view of the above and considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner, this Court allows the prayer made in the present CMP. Accordingly, the learned Senior Civil Judge, Bhubaneswar, is directed to hear the aforesaid suits analogously. The parties shall cooperate with the learned Court for expeditious disposal of the aforesaid suits and shall not seek unnecessary adjournments.
7. Accordingly, the CMP is, disposed of.
