A W A R D

1. Heard Mr. Chandrashekhar A. Chakalabbi, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr. Ajay M., learned counsel appearing for the respondent(s). We have also interacted with the Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Hassan, Karnataka and Ms. Rashana Shetty, daughter of the deceased appellant.
2. Ms. Rashana Shetty submits that the matter has been settled, The daughter of the deceased

appellant does not wish to pursue the matter.

3. The settlement is in the following terms :

"After the service of the notice issued by the District Legal Services Authority, Hassan, the parties appeared before the mediator Smt. M.B. Girijambika for mediation. Mediation was held on different dates i.e. 20.07.2026, 22.07.2026 and finally on 10.08.2026. And on 10.08.2026 in the mediation later that dispute between the parties has been amicably settled through the mediation proceedings held by the mediator. All the parties have arrived at a settlement by the intervention of the mediator Smt. M.B. Girijambika. The talks of settlement have been successfully held conducted by there mediator in between the remaining all parties to the case including the LRs of deceased appellant/Raviraja Shetty. There in the said settlement the LR's of the deceased appellant Smt. Rashana G. Shetty and other respondents arrived to the conclusion that being the LR's of appellant Smt. Rashana G. Shetty doesn't want to continue the above matter because her father deceased Raviraja Shetty had already received the Gratuity amount from the respondents. After receiving the said amount the deceased Raviraja Shetty had preferred the C.A No.9529/2019 before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, for seeking interest on Gratuity amount and challenging the order passed in WP No.1756/2025 on 01.08.2019. The LR's of Raviraja Shetty i.e. Smt. Rashana G. Shetty gave consent to not to contest the above matter preferred by her father. As such she want to withdraw the above C.A. No.9529/2019 filed by her father."

4. The Civil Appeal stands disposed of in terms of the settlement.
