ORDER

Present: None for the Appellant.
Deputy Registrar, NCLT, Chennai.

This Appeal has been preferred under Rule 63 of NCLT Rules, 2016 against the order dated 23.03.2026, whereby the Registry declined to register the application under Section 42 of IBC, 2016 (Diary No.3305118005752026). The defect(s) pointed out by the Registry are as under:-

“1. To remove condone delay application and also affidavit to file separately along with payment of Rs.1000/- in the e-filing portal and mention Condone delay application e-file no. in the prayer of this application to enable us to process together. (No. of days be calculated from 15th day of the rejection of the claim to till filing of this application, not complied and returned.

2. To include all Respondents in case details of the e-filing portal and file proof of service to us as per their mail id.

3. To file Form B (claim submitted) which is mentioned in rejection letter by the liquidator at page 349.

4. To correct the word from Company appeal to Company petition ad mention Petition no. and IA (IBC)//2026 i.e... (IA (IBC)//2026 in C.P. (IB)/883(CHE)2019 in all pages wherever applicable.

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5. As per the amended stamp paper act of Tamil Nadu, Affidavit should be filed on Rs.200/- in NJSP To file another Rs. 100/- stamp paper duly attested and notarised (Affidavit purchased date on or before signed date of the verifying affidavit), ”

It is stated that the Appellant filed the application on the e-filing portal on 12.02.2026. The Registry issued a defect note on 17.02.2026. However, the same was not brought to the knowledge of the Appellant.

It is stated that only on 27.02.2026 when the junior Counsel enquired with the Registry, he was made to understand that there are defects. On further enquiry, it was learnt that the email communications were sent to legal@pwilsonassociates.in. It is stated that the email was missed by the Appellant.

It is stated that because of the above, the defects could not be rectified in time.

It is stated that the Appellant complied with the defects mentioned in the notice dated 25.02.2026 and re-filed the appeal on 03.03.2026 after curing all the defects pointed out by the Registry.

It is stated that on 13.03.2026, the Registry sent an e-mail dated 25.02.2026 recording the same defects.

It is stated that the Registry on 23.03.2026, declined to register the Application on the ground that the defects were not rectified.

It is stated that the Appellant rectified the defects mentioned the defect notice dated 17.02.2026, 25.02.2026 and 13.03.2026.

Considering the submissions in the application, appeal is allowed.
