1. The petitioner's claim for family pension and other financial benefits have been kept in abeyance by the respondents Damodar Valley Corporation (in short "DVC") for the reasons best know to them.
2. The petitioner, a widow of the deceased employee, had filed a suit being Title Suit No. 217 of 2018 in which the daughter of the deceased employee as well as the DVC were parties. The suit has been decreed on October 8, 2024. It appears from a copy of the judgment that the Court has held that the plaintiff, the petitioner herein, is entitled to get the death/service benefit and pension of the deceased.
3. The petitioner is at liberty to approach the respondent no. 2 with her prayer for release of the benefits, as stipulated in the decree. The respondent no. 2 will consider the application if so made in the light of the judgment and decree passed by the learned Court below.
4. With the afore-stated observations, the writ petition is

disposed of.

5. There shall, however, be no order as to costs.
