A W A R D

1. As of now the settlement has not been entered into between the parties.

2. Learned counsel for the parties in chorus would submit that they are agreeable for resolution of the dispute and in furtherance of the same, respondent no 1-Oriental Insurance Co. Ltd. has offered to pay a sum of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rs. Ten Lakh Only) as global compensation which would be in addition to the compensation awarded by the High Court. The said offer is

accepted by the petitioner-claimant. Accordingly, placing their submission on record. The said enhanced compensation, namely, Rs. 10,00,000/- shall be deposited before the jurisdictional tribunal within a period of thirty days from the receipt of the uploading of the order. On such deposit being made, the petitioner-claimant would be at liberty to withdraw the same.

3. The petitioner-claimant is at liberty to furnish the bank details to transfer the amount through NEFT/RTGS, if he so desires.

4. Learned counsel for the parties state that award may be passed in terms of settlement arrived at before the Special Lok Adalat.

5. Registry to draw the award accordingly.

6. The special leave petition is disposed of in terms of the aforesaid settlement.
