Heard the parties.

This civil miscellaneous petition has been filed by the petitioners with the prayer for restoration of W.P.(C) No.2273 of 2015 to its original file which stood dismissed for default on 24.07.2025.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that W.P.(C) No.2273 of 2015 stood dismissed for default on 24.07.2025 by this Court. It is next submitted that due to inadvertence, the case could not be marked by the conducting counsel, hence, the learned counsel for the petitioners could not appear before this Court when the said W.P.(C) No.2273 of 2015 was called out, resulting in dismissal of the said W.P.(C) No.2273 of 2015 for default of the petitioners. It is next submitted that default of the petitioners before this Court on 24.07.2025 was neither deliberate nor intentional. It is also submitted that the

petitioners have very good grounds to agitate in the said W.P.(C) No.2273 of 2015 and unless the same is restored to its original file, the petitioners will be highly prejudiced. Hence, it is submitted that the W.P.(C) No.2273 of 2015 be restored to its original file.

Learned counsel appearing for the opposite parties have not raised any serious objection.

Considering the aforesaid submission of the learned counsel for the petitioners and the facts and circumstances of this case, W.P.(C) No.2273 of 2015 is directed to be restored to its original file at the same stage at which it was before its dismissal.

Registry is directed to list W.P.(C) No.2273 of 2015 before the concerned Bench after a week.

This Civil Miscellaneous Petition is disposed of accordingly.
