1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. The petitioner has approached this Court with the following prayer:

The petitioner therefore prays that your Lordship may graciously be pleased to admit this Writ application and issue a Rule NISI calling upon the Opp. Parties to file their show cause as to why this Writ application shall not be allowed and after hearing counsel from both sides this Hon'ble Court kindly issue a Writ in the nature of a Writ of "Mandamus" directing the Opp. Parties especially the Opp. Party No. 2 and 6 i.e. the Collector, Balasore and Tahasildar, Remuna respectively to settle and issue Record of Rights (R.O.R) in favour of the petitioner with regard to the Bhoodan Gifted land vide Annexure-1 of the Writ application as per order dated 13.05.2005 vide Annexure-2 and order dated 05.06.2017 vide Annexure-3 of the Writ application within a stipulated period as fixed by this Hon'ble Court for the ends of Justice and equity;

And/or any other order/orders, direction/ directions may be issued as to give complete relief to the petitioner;



And for this act of kindness, the petitioner shall as in duty bound, ever pray.

3. It is submitted that the petitioner had earlier approached this Court in W.P.(C) No. 30266 of 2024. A Coordinate Bench of this Court disposed of the said writ application by directing that the request of the petitioner for settlement of the land shall be duly examined by the Tahasildar, Remuna by passing an order after hearing the petitioner. It is further submitted that despite such clear directions, the matter has remained pending before the Tahasildar.

4. Considering the submissions, the writ application is disposed of directing the Tahasildar, Remuna to consider and dispose of the matter as directed by this Court earlier without any further delay and in any case, not later than four weeks from the date of production of certified copy of this order by the petitioner.
