This is a petition filed under Section 406 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short “Cr.P.C.”). The petitioner has filed this Transfer Petition seeking the following reliefs:

- “(a) Transfer the case being Case No.C/2029/2021 titled as “***M/s Macintel Solutions v. Mr. Sunil Kedia***” pending before the Court of the learned Judicial Magistrate, 6th Court, Alipore, South 24 Parganas, West Bengal to the Court of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ranchi, Jharkhand in the interest of justice; and/or
- (b) Pass such further or other order or orders as this Hon’ble Court may deem fit in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

2. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the respondent and on perusal of the

material on record, we find that the petitioner has made out a case for transfer of the aforesaid petition.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent-company submitted that having regard to the medical ailment of the petitioner, appropriate orders may be made in this case.

4. In the result, the Transfer Petition is allowed and Case No.C/2029/2021 titled “**M/s Macintel Solutions vs. Mr. Sunil Kedia**” pending before the Court of the learned Judicial Magistrate, 6th Court, Alipore, South 24 Parganas, West Bengal is ordered to be transferred to the Court of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ranchi, Jharkhand.

5. The respondent’s representative however is at liberty to appear before the transferee Court either in-person or through video conferencing facility. If such a request is made by the respondent’s representative, the Court shall make available the said facility to him.

6. Registry to communicate this order to the transferor Court as well as the transferee Court for taking steps in accordance with this order.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
