Further to our intimation dated August 14, 2023 (Ref. No. ISL/SS/SE/32/2023-2024) regarding pending material litigations/disputes that may impact the Company, in compliance with Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, read with Schedule III, Part A, Para B, and SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD-PoD-1/P/CIR/2023/123 dated July 13, 2023 followed by HO/49/14/14(7)2025-CFD-POD2/II/3762/2026 dated January 30, 2026.

The litigation between Kerala Medical Services Corporation Limited (KMSCL) and the Company has been amicably resolved through mediation. The Mediation Settlement Agreement was submitted before the Hon’ble High Court of Kerala at Ernakulam on April 10, 2026. Based on the settlement arrived at between the parties, the Hon’ble Court passed its order on the same date and disposed of the matter.

The certified copy of the order was received from the Company's Advocate on June 03, 2026, at 10:36 A.M. (IST). Consequently, the demand of Rs. 75.89 lakhs raised against the Company stands resolved and disposed of in terms of the settlement and the Court's order.
