O R D E R

1. Heard Mr. Sanjay Sen, learned senior counsel appearing for the appellant(s).
2. The Appellate Tribunal for Electricity (for short, 'APTEL') By the order impugned before us, has remitted the matter to the Gujarat Electricity Regulatory Commission (for short, 'GERC') for conducting the prudence check with respect to (a) capital cost of the project; (b) higher cost for construction of transmission line; and (c) to consider the capacity utilization factor.
3. While we are not inclined to interfere with the order passed by the APTEL in the appeal(s) against the matter(s) remanding the matter for determination of conducting prudence check, we direct the GERC to take up and dispose of the petition(s) as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of four months from today.
4. The appellant is at liberty to approach the APTEL for fixation

of interim tariff during the pendency of the matter before the
GERC, if necessary and if so, advised.

5. With this clarification, the Civil Appeals are disposed of.
