2. A period of two weeks is granted to the Respondent/ Corporate Debtor for filing reply from the date of receipt of notice, with an advance copy to be supplied to the Ld. Counsel representing the Financial Creditor. Thereafter, Financial Creditor, if required, would file rejoinder within another period of two weeks with an advance copy to be supplied to the Ld. Counsel representing the Corporate Debtor.
3. Meanwhile, the Applicant/ Financial Creditor has also been asked to obtain the Record of Default (RoD) issued by NeSL and file to be part of the record.
4. Let the matter be adjourned for further hearing on 11th August, 2026.
