Dr. Kartikey Hari Gupta, Advocate for the respondent. 3. Petitioner took a term loan of Rs.20,00,000/- from Nainital Bank Ltd. Since there was some default in repayment of the loan, therefore, the bank invoked its powers under SARFAESI Act, 2002. 4. In this writ petition, petitioner has challenged a notice issued under Section 13 (2) of SARFAESI Act, 2002. 5. Dr. Kartikey Hari Gupta, learned counsel appearing for the bank, on instructions, submits that the total outstanding in the loan account of petitioner as on today is Rs.5,54,759/-. He submits that if petitioner makes representation under Section 13(3A) of SARFAESI Act, the same shall be considered sympathetically.



6. The writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of with liberty to petitioner to make representation to the competent authority in the bank by 07.09.2026. Representation, if made within stipulated time, shall be decided sympathetically, within 15 days from the date of production of certified copy of this order. Till decision on petitioner's representation, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner.
