**Sub: Scrutinizer's Report on remote e-voting and e-voting conducted at the 44th
Annual General Meeting of M/s. Super Sales India Limited held on 20th July
2026.**

I, M D Selvaraj, FCS, Managing Partner of M/s. MDS & Associates LLP, Company Secretaries, Coimbatore, have been appointed by the Board of Directors of **M/s. Super Sales India Limited** ("the Company") as the Scrutinizer for the purpose of scrutinizing the remote e-voting process and the e-voting conducted at the 44th Annual General Meeting in a fair and transparent manner and for the purpose of ascertaining the requisite majority on the remote e-voting and e-voting at the 44th Annual General Meeting on the resolution(s) as set out in the Notice convening the 44th Annual General Meeting of the Company held on Monday, 20th July 2026 at 3:30 PM (IST) through Video Conferencing (VC) / Other Audio-Visual Means (OAVM) in accordance with the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended), Regulation 44 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and the relevant circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA Circulars") from time to time permitting the conduct of the Annual General Meeting through VC / OAVM facility.



Responsibility of the Management

The Management of the Company is responsible to ensure compliance with the requirements of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules made thereunder in relation to exercising of voting rights through electronic means, on the resolution(s) as set out in the Notice convening the 44th Annual General Meeting dated 18th May 2026.

Responsibility as a Scrutinizer

My responsibility, as a Scrutinizer for the remote e-voting process and for the e-voting at the 44th Annual General Meeting, is restricted to the preparation of a Scrutinizer's Report on the votes cast "in favour" or "against" the resolution(s), as set out in Item No. 1 to Item No. 6 in the Notice convening the 44th Annual General Meeting of the Company dated 18th May 2026, based on the reports generated from the e-voting system provided by M/s. National Securities Depository Limited ("NSDL"), the Authorized Agency, engaged by the Company for providing e-voting facilities.

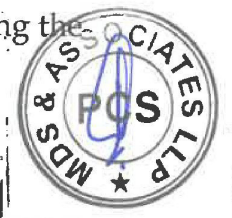
Further, since the meeting was held through VC/ OAVM facility in accordance with the said MCA Circulars, the facility of appointment of proxies was not made available for the meeting. Accordingly, no proxy registers were made or maintained by the Company in respect of the said meeting.

Further, in addition to the above, I submit my report as under:

- a. The Notice dated 18th May 2026 convening the 44th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Company along with necessary statement setting out the material facts under Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 and the disclosure under Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended), in respect of the below mentioned resolution(s) to be passed at the said 44th Annual General Meeting of the Company, were sent through electronic mail to the members who had registered their email address with the Company / Depositories in accordance with the said MCA Circulars. The Company has also placed the notice of the 44th Annual General Meeting on its website. Further, the Company has also sent a letter providing the web link including the exact path where the complete details of the Annual Report is available to those shareholders who had not registered their email address in accordance with SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015.
- b. The Company has availed the e-voting services offered by NSDL for providing the remote e-voting and the facility of e-voting during the meeting to the shareholders of the Company.



- c. The remote e-voting period commenced on Friday, 17th July 2026 at 9:00 AM (IST) and ended on Sunday, 19th July 2026 at 5:00 PM (IST). During the period, the members of the Company, holding shares in physical and/or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date i.e., 13th July 2026 were entitled to vote on the resolutions set out in the Notice of the 44th Annual General Meeting. The remote e-voting module of NSDL was disabled on Sunday, 19th July 2026 at 5:00 PM.
- d. Upon the commencement of the 44th Annual General Meeting, the e-voting platform was activated to enable the shareholders who were present at the 44th Annual General Meeting through video conferencing / other audio-visual means and who had not cast their vote on the resolutions through remote e-voting to vote through e-voting facility at the Meeting. After the conclusion of the proceedings at 4.05 PM, the Chairman extended the e-voting facility for another 15 minutes to enable the members to cast their votes. The e-voting facility provided at the meeting was disabled at the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting.
- e. I, as the Scrutinizer, unblocked the votes cast by the Shareholders of the Company through the e-voting process on 20th July 2026 at 4.25 PM (IST) in the presence of Mr. S. Sarathraj (Witness No.1) and Ms. S. Poornima (Witness No.2), who are not in employment of the Company in accordance with Rule 20(4)(xii) of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended).
- f. Thereafter, the details containing *inter alia* the list of Equity Shareholders of the Company, who have cast "for" or "against" each of the resolution(s) that were put to vote through remote e-voting process and e-voting at the meeting, were generated from the e-voting portal of NSDL.
- g. I have scrutinized the votes cast by remote e-voting and by e-voting at the Annual General Meeting and maintained registers in which necessary entries have been made in accordance with the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended).
- h. Based on the reports generated from the e-voting portal of NSDL, I hereby submit my Combined Report on the results of the votes cast by the shareholders of the Company through remote e-voting and e-voting at the meeting on the resolution(s) as set out under Item No.1 to Item No.6 of the Notice convening the 44th Annual General Meeting as under:
