UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. Heard Mr. Balbir Singh, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner.
3. After the impugned order dated 11.11.2025, on 08.12.2025, the petitioner has filed Interlocutory application for vacation of the order before the High Court. Thereafter, an application was filed to direct the Trial Judge to hear the petition under

Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short, 'A&C Act') filed by the respondent challenging the award in favour of the petitioner. The High Court has directed that the said application filed under Section 34 of the A&C Act should be disposed of at the earliest. Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner submits that the award is of 17.03.2017 and in spite of getting interim orders of attachment, today all the orders remained stayed including the execution proceedings itself.

4. Be that as it may, we are of the opinion that the interest of justice would be served, if we direct the Court of District Judge at Patna, Bihar to decide to Misc.Arbitration Case No.36/2017 along with 80/2017 on or before 31.08.2026.

5. We are making this order, as the award is of 2017 and it is already 09 years since the award has been passed.

6. With the above observations, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
