- 1.** Ld. Counsel representing the Income Tax Department states that there was some discrepancy in the nomenclature of the Appellant Company that it is in fact Jaydev Infratech Pvt. Ltd., but it is wrongly mentioned in the affidavit as Jaydev Propmart Pvt. Ltd.
- 2.** Because of this, the report of the Income Tax Department could not be filed as the documents were to be collected with respect to the correctly named company concerned. He further submits that as per his instructions, there is a demand of Rs.8.79 lack for the Assessment Year 2015-16, raised by the department against the said company.
- 3.** Ld. Counsel representing the Appellant states that the said demand would be paid within a period of one week and an affidavit to that effect would also be filed.
- 4.** Ld. Counsel representing the RoC seeks yet another opportunity to file the
