UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. IA No. 217110 of 2026, is an application for impleadment of Director, All India Institute of Medical Sciences, as a respondent in the matter. The application is allowed. Cause title be amended accordingly.
2. The petitioner before this Court has filed the

present petition being aggrieved by the non-inclusion of her name in the merit list prepared for the post of Agniveer (Vayu).

3. Petitioner's contention is that when she reported for joining on 30.12.2025, she was declared medically unfit by the medical board on the ground of "*Accessory Nipple Bilateral*", and the Appeal Medical Board on 06.02.2026 has again affirmed the findings of the medical board dated 30.12.2025.

4. The petitioner has obtained a medical opinion from a board constituted by the Jawaharlal Nehru Government Medical College & Hospital, Aligarh Muslim University, Aligarh as well as specialists from the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi. Her contention is that two independent specialists have held her to be fit for the job in question.

5. Let the petitioner be subjected to a medical examination by a board constituted by AIIMS, New Delhi.

6. The Director, AIIMS, is requested to constitute a medical board in the matter, and the petitioner shall appear before the Director, AIIMS, New Delhi on 12.08.2026 at 10:30 am.

7. Let a report in a sealed envelope be submitted by the Director, AIIMS, New Delhi before this court by 13.08.2026 so that the matter can be decided on 14.08.2026.

8. Let complete set of documents be handed over to the standing counsel for Union of India (Ms. Aishwarya Bhati,

Additional Solicitor General) enabling her to ensure that the order is communicated today itself to the Director, AIIMS, New Delhi.

9. List the matter on 14.08.2026.
