ORDER
(Hybrid Mode)

The Applicant/Financial Creditor (FC) has filed an affidavit of service on 06.07.2026 vide Inward No. 5543. The affidavit discloses that notice upon the Personal Guarantor (PG) was served through registered post on 25.06.2026 and through electronic mode on 04.07.2026. However, it does not specify the date, if any, on which service by hand was effected.

As service through registered post was duly effected on 25.06.2026, the prescribed period of seven days for filing a reply has already expired. No reply or objection has been filed by the Personal Guarantor; only a Vakalatnama on behalf of the Personal Guarantor was filed on 06.07.2026.

Nevertheless, as a last opportunity, the Personal Guarantor is permitted to file a reply within a further period of seven days, subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) to the **Prime Minister National Relief Fund** within the said period.

The Applicant/Financial Creditor may file a rejoinder, if any, within seven days thereafter.

List the matter for further consideration on 24.07.2026.
