2. At the outset, learned Advocate for the respondents
referring to the relief sought for in the writ petition has apprised
this Court that the grievance of the petitioner is confined to the
notification dated 26.05.2022 as contained in Memo No.
R/PPU/939/22, whereby and whereunder the respondent No. 6
has been made Donor Member of the Governing Body of Ram
Lakhan Singh Yadav College in violation of the provisions



provided under Sub Clause-5 of Clause 1 of Section 60 of the Bihar Universities Act, 1976.

3. It is submitted at the Bar by the learned Advocate for the petitioner that during the pendency of the present writ petition, now a fresh Member Donor of the College has been elected and the same has also been challenged by filing CWJC No. 5685 of 2026.

4. In view thereof, the present writ petition stands dismissed having become infructuous.
