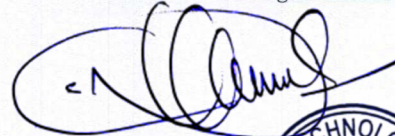

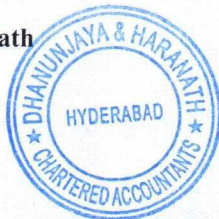

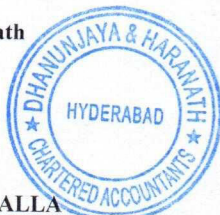

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF CONTAINTE TECHNOLOGIES LIMITED

Report on the audit of the Financial Results Opinion

We have audited the accompanying half yearly financial results of **Containe Technologies Limited** (the company) for the half year ended 31st March'2026 and year to date results for the period 1st April'2025 to 31st March'2026 attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("LODR Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us these financial results:

- i. are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the LODR Regulations in this regard; and
- ii. give a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable accounting standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net profit and other financial information of the company for the year ended March 31, 2026.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act). Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Results section of our report. We are independent of the Company in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial results under the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules thereunder, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements and the Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Emphasis of Matter

We draw attention to Note No. 20 to the accompanying financial statements regarding unbilled revenue aggregating to Rs. 210.15 Lakhs as at March 31, 2026 (Previous Year: Rs. 44.23 Lakhs), comprising of subscription and SIM connectivity charges incurred on behalf of customers and technical service charges relating to installation support services for speed limiting and tracking devices, pending billing as at the reporting date. Recognition and recoverability of these amounts involve management judgment and estimates relating to customer arrangements, completion of underlying services, subsequent billing and expected collections. Based on Management estimates the said balances are fully recoverable in the normal course of business.

Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.



Management's Responsibilities for the Financial Results:

These half yearly as well as year to date financial statements have been prepared on the basis of the audited financial statements. The Company's Board of Directors are responsible for the preparation and presentation of these financial results that give a true and fair view of the net profit and other financial information in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, including the accounting standards specified under Section 133 of the Act and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the statement that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, the Board of Directors are responsible for assessing the company's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern basis of accounting unless the Board of Directors either intends to liquidate the Company or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

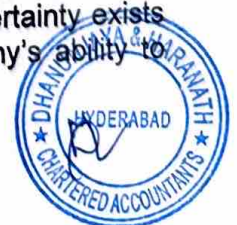
The Board of Directors are also responsible for overseeing the Company's financial reporting process.
