Independent Auditor's Report on Standalone Annual Financial Results of the Company Pursuant to the Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (as amended)

To the Board of Directors of Sri KPR Industries Limited

Opinion

1. We have audited the accompanying standalone annual financial results ('the Statement') of Sri KPR Industries Limited ('the Company') for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2026, attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (as amended) ('Listing Regulations').

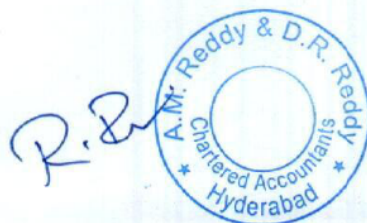


Responsibilities of Management and Those Charged with Governance for the Statement

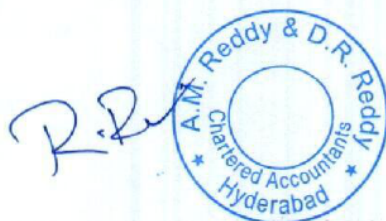

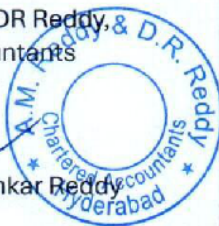
Other Matter
