Mr. Sachin Kumar Sharma, learned counsel for respondents, through V.C. 3. Petitioner has challenged the order dated 10.04.2026 passed by respondent no.4, whereby, from the amount of gratuity of the petitioner, deduction has been made and further a direction to the respondents to return the amount which was so deducted along with interest. 4. It is contended by learned Counsel for petitioner that the controversy in this writ petition is finally settled by the Division Bench of this Court in Special Appeal No.245 of 2022 (<i>Managing Director, Uttarakhand Transport Corporation v. Ashok Kr. Saxena</i>) and batch, decided on 04.04.2024. It is further contended that the case of petitioner is squarely covered by the judgment



			passed in aforesaid special appeal. 5. Learned Counsel appearing for respondent-Corporation also does not dispute this fact. 6. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of, in terms of judgment dated 04.04.2024 passed in SPA No.245 of 2022 (<i>Managing Director, Uttarakhand Transport Corporation v. Ashok Kr.
