Escorts Kubota marks three decades of Farmtrac with the 6055 Classic 'Dark Edition' and the PROMAXX 2.0 range

- 6055 Classic 'Dark Edition' is the first all-black tractor in Farmtrac's history, offered in both 2WD and 4WD.
- PROMAXX series expanded up to 50 HP with two models, the 47 HT PROMAXX and the 50 PROMAXX, both available in 2WD and 4WD

Faridabad, September 02, 2026: Escorts Kubota, the agri-machinery and construction equipment major, marked three decades of its Farmtrac brand in India with two new offerings. The **6055 Classic 'Dark Edition'** is the first all-black tractor in the Farmtrac portfolio, a 55 HP category model offered in both two-wheel drive (2WD) and four-wheel drive (4WD) variants. Alongside it, the PROMAXX series has been expanded under "PROMAXX 2.0" with two new models, the **47 HT PROMAXX (47 HP)** and the **50 PROMAXX (50 HP category)**, both available in 2WD and 4WD.

The company operates three tractor brands in India, namely Kubota, Farmtrac and Powertrac, catering to premium, entry-premium and value segments respectively. Escorts launched Farmtrac in 1995, and the brand today spans the 26 HP to 60 HP range in India.

The Farmtrac 6055 Classic 'Dark Edition' is powered by a robust four-cylinder, 3682 cc engine that delivers maximum torque of 247 Nm, ensuring performance under demanding field conditions. It carries a 2,500 kg heavy-duty hydraulic lift, premium LED lighting and a heat shield, and has been designed for progressive farmers and larger landholdings that require high productivity and durability. Built to handle a wide range of advanced applications, it is suited to implements including the super seeder, laser leveler, reversible mould board (MB) plough, rotavator and harrow, as well as heavy haulage.

The PROMAXX 2.0 range, comprising the 47 HT PROMAXX and the 50 PROMAXX, is powered by Farmtrac's advanced 3514 cc HT (High Torque) engine delivering up to 230 Nm of torque. Both models carry a 12 forward and 3 reverse gearbox, a creeper speed option and a spacious flat platform for operator comfort. Engineered to meet the evolving needs of modern farming, the range combines higher torque, advanced technology and 4WD variants that are capable to support demanding applications.

Commenting on the launch, **Nikhil Nanda, Chairman and Managing Director** said, *"The 6055 Classic 'Dark Edition' and the PROMAXX 2.0 range are in line with our vision of strengthening the portfolio through focused, application-led products. Farmtrac has completed three decades in India, and the brand continues to anchor our position across key horsepower categories. Each such introduction is a deliberate step towards our ambition of a stronger market position in India."*

Akira Kato, Deputy Managing Director said, *"The 41 to 50 HP category continues to dominate the domestic market as the largest segment. However, customer demand within this space is shifting rapidly towards four-wheel drive and higher torque, driven by farmers undertaking more demanding applications. The 47 HT PROMAXX and the 50 PROMAXX represent a natural progression for a series that*

has already established a strong market presence, and the 'Dark Edition' extends that same choice of drive and styling into the premium 55 HP category."

Neeraj Mehra, Chief Officer, Tractor Business Division added, "Over the past five to eight years, the rising adoption of heavy-duty mechanisation, coupled with a new generation of youth entering agriculture as primary decision-makers, has significantly evolved customer expectations. Farmers today are shifting away from basic tractors towards multi-utility machines that offer superior comfort and modern styling. The PROMAXX 2.0 answers that with its HT engine, creeper speed option and spacious flat platform, while the 6055 Classic 'Dark Edition', Farmtrac's first ever black tractor, pairs a bold aesthetic with robust performance. We are confident both launches will strengthen the Farmtrac brand and expand our footprint among progressive, technologically advanced farming communities."

Both new offerings are being introduced through Farmtrac's authorized dealer network.
