This is an application to extend the time granted for curing the defects.

The facts giving rise to present IA (re-filing) are that the Appellant e-filed the Memo of Appeal on 18.04.2026. The Office after scrutiny of the Memo of Appeal on 27.04.2026, intimated the defects to the Appellant on the same day. The Appellant re-filed the Appeal on 13.07.2026. It is stated in the IA that after filing of the Appeal, certain defects were notified which required some time to rectify. Considerable time was consumed in coordinating across jurisdictions and obtaining complete instructions and records relating to the impugned proceedings and connected litigation. The delay is thus bona fide, unintentional, and neither deliberate nor attributable to any negligence, and if the same is not condoned, the Appellants/Applicants would suffer grave and irreparable prejudice. It is further submitted that the delay is neither intentional nor deliberate, but has occurred on account of bona fide and genuine reasons as stated herein above. The Appellants/Applicants therefore humbly prays that this Hon'ble Appellate Authority may be pleased to condone the delay in re-filing in the interest of justice.

Heard Ld. Counsel for Applicant and perused the averments made in the IA as well as Office report.

The Appellant was required to re-file the Memo of Appeal within seven days from the date of intimation of the defects. However, the Appellant re-filed the Memo of Appeal with a delay of 70 days, hence, the case may be placed before the Hon'ble Bench with defect for appropriate orders.
