ORDER
(Hybrid Mode)

A Service Affidavit has been filed on 13.07.2026 vide Inward No. D-5740, stating that notice upon the Respondent/Corporate Debtor was served through Registered Post and delivered on 02.07.2026, and through electronic mode, which reflects delivery on 29.06.2026.
