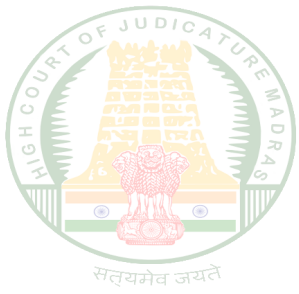

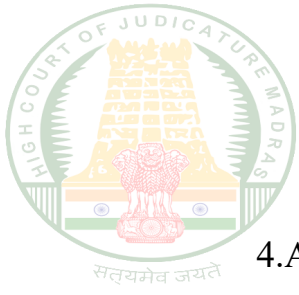

This petition is filed seeking exemption from surrender following the conviction and sentence imposed vide order dated 06.02.2026 of the learned I Additional District and Sessions Judge at Coimbatore in Crl.A.No.2 of 2024 while dismissing the appeal and consequentially confirming the Judgment dated 23.11.2023 of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Fast Track Court (Magistrate Level-II) at Coimbatore in CC.No.1055 of 2018.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the first respondent as well as the learned counsel appearing for the second respondent.

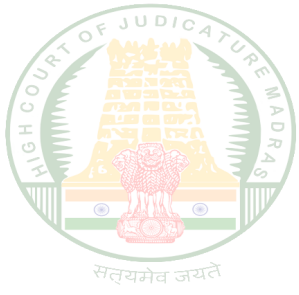
