O R D E R

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the High Court committed a manifest error in quashing the proceedings under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, by relying on a judgment which has been subsequently overruled. She submits that the decision of this Court in *Meters & Instruments (P) Ltd. v. Kanchan Mehta, (2018) 1 SCC 560*, had been overruled by a larger Bench of this Court in *Expeditious Trial of Cases Under Section 138*

*of NI Act, 1881, In re,*(2021) 16 SCC 116. That apart, the High Court did not consider any interest or compensation to be paid to the complainant.
