ORDER

The present Appeal has been filed under Rule 63 of the NCLT Rules, 2016 seeking setting aside of the order dated 16.03.2026 passed by the Ld. Registrar of this Bench.

2. It has been observed that Ld. Registrar vide order dated 16.03.2026 pointed out some defects which are as follows:

(i) *Notary ticket not clear in affidavit*

(ii) *Applicant's sign not in prayer.*

3. Ld. Registrar is specifically mentioned that if you are aggrieved you may file an appeal within 15 days as per Rule 63 of the NCLT Rules before this Bench. On perusal it is found that appeal was filed before the designated Appellate

Authority of National Company Law Tribunal on 11.06.2026 which is beyond 15 days and the applicant has submitted in his application that some delay has been caused in filing the appeal against order dated 16.03.2026 passed by learned Registrar NCLT New Delhi. The delay is not deliberate but due to some unavoidable reasons, which were beyond control to the respondent as such, the same is liable to be condoned by this Hon'ble Tribunal.

4. During the call of this matter nobody appears on behalf of the appellant. No sufficient grounds given in the application for condonation of delay.
5. In view of the above facts and circumstances of the case the appeal is rejected.
6. Accordingly, Appeal No.11/Chd/Hry/2026 stands ***dismissed and disposed of.***
