Dear Sir / Madam,

Pursuant to Regulation 30 read with Para A of Part A of Schedule III of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“SEBI LODR Regulations”), we hereby inform that the Hon’ble Securities Appellate Tribunal, Mumbai (“SAT”), vide its Order dated May 07, 2026 in Appeal No. 39 of 2026 (along with Miscellaneous Application Nos. 152 & 153 of 2026), has passed a final order in the matter of Apollo Ingredients Limited (Formerly Known as Indsoya Limited) versus BSE Limited.

The Company had filed the aforesaid appeal challenging the communication dated November 01, 2025 issued by BSE Limited in relation to rejection of waiver application for fines imposed by the Exchange.

After hearing the parties, the Hon’ble SAT has passed, inter alia, the following directions:

1. Learned counsel for the Appellant sought permission to withdraw the Appeal.
2. The Hon’ble SAT permitted withdrawal of the Appeal and dismissed the same as withdrawn.
3. BSE Limited was permitted to collect the amount of Rs. 2,06,000/- together with accrued interest, which had been deposited in an interest-bearing account pursuant to the earlier order dated February 26, 2026.
4. The Appellant Company had no objection to BSE Limited collecting the said amount along with accrued interest.
5. All pending interlocutory applications, if any, stand disposed of.
