O R D E R

1. The prayer of the respondent for suspension of sentence was accepted by the Appellate Court subject to a deposit of 20% of the amount in question. The High Court reduced the same to 10% against which the petitioner filed a criminal appeal which was allowed vide order dated 14.05.2026. Consequently, the order of the High Court reducing the amount to be deposited was set aside and the order of the Appellate Court was restored.
2. In such circumstances, if the appellant has not made the requisite deposit, it is for the Appellate Court to address the consequences.
3. In our view the contempt petitions are misconceived. The petitions are, accordingly, dismissed.
