1. This is an application for modification of order dated 22.05.2026 passed in W.P.(C) No.16524 of 2026.

2. After hearing learned counsel for the Petitioner, the expression "A/c No.42541993341" mentioned in the order dated 22.05.2026 is corrected as "A/c No.32230106279". Rest part of the said order remains unaltered.

3. The I.A. is disposed of.

5. Heard Mr. S.C. Dash, learned counsel for the Petitioner.



6. Mr. P.V. Balakrishna, learned counsel, who appears for the Opposite Parties-Bank, submits that the freezing order of the account was issued pursuant to the instruction received from the Police authority. He further confirms that the alleged unauthorized transaction is to the tune of Rs.1000/-.

7. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to Opposite Party No.3 to permit the Petitioner to operate his Bank Account No.32230106279 keeping lien over an amount of Rs.1000/-, till such instructions received from Opposite Party No.4.

8. An urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application.
