UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the impugned order dated 29.04.2026 passed by the High Court.

2. Paragraph No.4 of the impugned order reads thus:

"Thus, in view of the order passed by this Court dated 19.01.2026 in Writ Petition No.7311 of 2022, the present petition is nothing but an abuse of the process of law. Accordingly, the petition stands

dismissed with costs of Rs.21,000/-, to be deposited in the "Public Welfare Account" maintained with Union Bank of India, High Court Branch, Civil Lines, Nagpur, within a period of four weeks from today. Failure to deposit the said amount within the stipulated period, the Tahsildar is directed to recover the same as arrears of land revenue from the petitioner."

3. While we concur with the view taken by the High Court that the prayer made by the petitioner may not have any merit, imposition of cost is not warranted, more particularly considering the fact that petitioner is a student.

4. We, accordingly, set aside Paragraph No.4 of the impugned order dated 29.04.2026.

5. However, the Writ Petition being Writ Petition No.3317 of 2026 has been dismissed.

6. The Special Leave Petition is, consequently, disposed of.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
