Mr. Lalit Sharma, learned Deputy Solicitor General of India and Mr. Manoj Kumar, learned C.G.C. for the Union of India/respondent no.1. 3. Mr. J.S. Bisht, learned Standing Counsel along with Mr. Devesh Ghildiyal, learned Brief Holder for the State of Uttarakhand/respondent no.2. 4. Learned counsel for the respondents-contemnors supplied the instructions dated 21.07.2026 as well as the e-mail dated 21.07.2026, and the same are taken on record. On instructions, it is submitted that order passed by Writ Court in WPMS No.1807 of 2026 (<i>Ranipur Private Industrial Training Institute vs. Union of India & others</i>) has been complied with. Out of six students, four students came to the College and participated in the practical examination. So far as the other two students are concerned, since they could not appear in the practical examination, arrangements have been made for them to participate in the supplementary practical examination as and when



such examination is held. Thus, he submits that the order has already been complied with.

5. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners does not dispute the said contention raised on behalf of the respondents-contemnors. He also admits that the order has now been complied with.

6. Accordingly, the contempt petition is hereby closed.
