This is an application to extend the time granted for curing the defects.

The facts giving rise to present IA (re-filing) are that the Appellant e-filed the Memo of Appeal on 25.05.2026. The Office after scrutiny of the Memo of Appeal on 01.06.2026, intimated the defects to the Appellant on the same day. The Appellant re-filed the Appeal on 15.07.2026. It is stated in the IA that the defects raised inter alia were that numerous pages in the Appeal were dim and illegible, which were to be typed and took some time. Further, there were partial Court working days in the month of June in Delhi and the Appellant's lawyer was unavailable. Hence, there is delay of 36 days in re-filing the Memo of Appeal, so the same may be condoned.

None appeared on behalf of the Appellant. Perused the averments made in the IA as well as Office report.

The Appellant was required to re-file the Memo of Appeal within seven days from the date of intimation of the defects. However, the Appellant re-filed the Memo of Appeal with a delay of 37 days, hence, the case may be placed before the Hon'ble Bench with defect for appropriate orders.
